# Honoring the Movement

The Community Partnership for Transition Solutions (CPTS) in Washington State began as a grassroots movement in the late 1990's spurred by faculty, staff and students of South Seattle Community College and many others who saw the need for support of individuals working to reintegrate into their communities post incarceration. They noted that education, social support, human connection and purpose played a huge role in their recovery journey as well as the adjustment and transition associated with exiting a controlled incarceration environment.

Since that time, the movement has grown in recognition, size and impact. There are now CPTS coalitions across the State of Washington that work to build community partnerships around this work. Thousands of individuals have received support from this network of partnerships and moved towards a thriving life.

At the Annual Summer Institute, we gather to celebrate those who have laid the foundation for this body of work and those engaging in supporting individuals returning to our communities and their families. This is an annual opportunity to listen, learn, grow, partner and effect change. Re-Entry work is expanding across our State and we are excited to highlight the wins of 2023-2024 at this year's 17th Annual Summer Institute.
